

IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution

Congress has passed the law that allows Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD) directly to qualified charities permanently, each and every year!

Under the QCD, you can elect to make a distribution directly from your IRA to the School Sisters of St. Francis, and no income taxes are due because we are a tax-exempt charity.

A QCD is an especially attractive option because:

- ◆ It satisfies your required minimum distribution
- ◆ You can give more than your required minimum distribution—up to a limit of \$100,000.
- ◆ No tax is due on the distribution (subject to a \$100,000 limit).
- ◆ The money is immediately available to us to support the programs and work most important to you.

Suppose you want to make a \$10,000 gift, and you are also required to take a \$10,000 IRA distribution. If you take the IRA distribution and then make a cash gift, your total “out of pocket” cost is \$10,000 because any deduction you could take for the cash gift (assuming you itemize for federal taxes) will be offset by the tax due on the distribution. However, if you make your gift by directing your RMD to us as a QCD, you pay no tax on the distribution.

The QCD is also valuable to donors who do not itemize their tax return. With a qualified charitable distribution of an RMD, you can make a meaningful gift and pay no taxes on the required minimum distribution.

Making a gift to the School Sisters of St. Francis through a QCD is as easy as contacting the custodian of your IRA account and requesting the Qualified Charitable Distribution, Your custodian will help you complete the simple transfer of funds. Please notify us as well.
