



To be as diverse as possible we had lunch in Greek town. It turned out to be richly informative and a lovely way to spend another school day on a special field trip!

Wrigley Field holds 41,268 and she expects to steamroll past that figure eventually. Loretta has been drawing portraits of patrons of Murphy's Bleachers across from Wrigley for 34 years, charging \$5 a head. She drops both Murphy's and Cubs logos into each of her portraits.

Loretta is a self-taught artist who spent the first half of her life as a secretary. Since the late 1960s she's primarily made her living by sketching people around Chicago and occasionally being hired to teach watercolors.

She has drawn George Clooney (when he was in *E.R.*), many members of prominent Chicago families and McCormick's and Art Institute trustees. Loretta says she will retire at 100 and live to 110. She figures that she'll take 10 years off!


